- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Jail Standards Board; to amend section
- 2 83-4,131, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section
- 3 83-4,126, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2016; to change
- 4 provisions relating to powers and duties as prescribed; to harmonize
- 5 provisions; and to repeal the original sections.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 83-4,126, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 2 2016, is amended to read:
- 3 83-4,126 The (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this
- 4 section, the Jail Standards Board shall have the authority and
- 5 responsibility:
- 6 (1) (a) To develop minimum standards for the construction,
- 7 maintenance, and operation of criminal detention facilities;
- 8 (2) (b) To perform other duties as may be necessary to carry out the
- 9 policy of the state regarding criminal detention facilities, juvenile
- 10 detention facilities, and staff secure juvenile facilities as stated in
- 11 sections 83-4,124 to 83-4,134.01; and
- 12 (3) (c) Consistent with the purposes and objectives of the Juvenile
- 13 Services Act, to develop standards for juvenile detention facilities and
- 14 staff secure juvenile facilities, including, but not limited to,
- 15 standards for physical facilities, care, programs, and disciplinary
- 16 procedures, and to develop guidelines pertaining to the operation of such
- 17 facilities.
- 18 (2) The Jail Standards Board shall not have authority over or
- 19 responsibility for correctional facilities that are accredited by a
- 20 nationally recognized correctional association. A correctional facility
- 21 that is accredited by a nationally recognized correctional association
- 22 shall show proof of accreditation annually to the Jail Standards Board.
- 23 For purposes of this subsection, nationally recognized correctional
- 24 association includes, but is not limited to, the American Correctional
- 25 Association or its successor.
- Sec. 2. Section 83-4,131, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 27 amended to read:
- 28 83-4,131 Personnel of the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and
- 29 Criminal Justice shall visit and inspect each criminal detention
- 30 facility, juvenile detention facility, and staff secure juvenile facility
- 31 in the state, except correctional facilities accredited by a nationally

- 1 recognized correctional association pursuant to subsection (2) of section
- 2 83-4,126, for the purpose of determining the conditions of confinement,
- 3 the treatment of persons confined in the facilities, and whether such
- 4 facilities comply with the minimum standards established by the Jail
- 5 Standards Board. A written report of each inspection shall be made within
- 6 thirty days following such inspection to the appropriate governing body
- 7 responsible for the criminal detention facility, juvenile detention
- 8 facility, or staff secure juvenile facility involved. The report shall
- 9 specify those areas in which the facility does not comply with the
- 10 required minimum standards.
