LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 131

Introduced by Riepe, 12.

PURPOSE: Title X family planning clinics play a critical role in ensuring access to a broad range of family planning and preventive health services.

It is the purpose of this resolution for the Health and Human Services Committee of the Legislature to conduct an interim study to examine the distribution and use of Federal Title X Program state and federal appropriations.

This study shall examine the following:

- (1) The distribution of Title X funding in Nebraska;
- (2) The providers of Title X funding in Nebraska;
- (3) The recipients of Title X funding in Nebraska;
- (4) Policies, programs, and procedures of other states regarding distribution and use of Federal Title X funds; and
- (5) Legal implications of prioritizing Title X funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED FIFTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, FIRST SESSION:

1. That the Health and Human Services Committee of the Legislature shall be designated to conduct an interim study to carry out the purposes of this resolution.

2. That the committee shall upon the conclusion of its study make a report of its findings, together with its recommendations, to the Legislative Council or Legislature.
