LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 223

Introduced by Blood, 3.

PURPOSE: The purpose of this resolution is to study Nebraska statutes governing the use of personally identifiable information and to determine if the standards governing such information are applied consistently. The study committee shall examine statutes, rules and regulations, and policies governing the use of personally identifiable information by government entities in Nebraska, including state agencies and political subdivisions. The study committee shall evaluate whether a more consistent standard should be applied and recommend any statutory changes the study committee finds beneficial.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED FIFTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, FIRST SESSION:

1. That the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee of the Legislature shall be designated to conduct an interim study to carry out the purposes of this resolution.

2. That the committee shall upon the conclusion of its study make a report of its findings, together with its recommendations, to the Legislative Council or Legislature.
