LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 76

Introduced by Brewer, 43.

WHEREAS, the Valentine High School wrestling team won the 2017 Class C State Wrestling Championship; and

WHEREAS, the Badgers set a class record with 195 points, breaking Tekamah-Herman's 1989 record of 192.5 points; and

WHEREAS, the Badgers tied their own state record with 17 pins; and

WHEREAS, the Badgers tied two more Class C State Championship records with the team's nine medalists and four individual champions; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature recognizes that the academic and athletic talent displayed by the Badgers is due in great part to the efforts of Coach Shane Allison and his team of outstanding assistant coaches, who are respected for their ability to develop potential into excellence; and

WHEREAS, the Badgers have established themselves as a team that embodies a brotherhood of athletic ability, of good sportsmanship, of honor, and of scholarship, reflecting favorably on Valentine High School; and

WHEREAS, poised eagerly with enthusiasm and determined purpose, the Badgers now stand honorably, with just pride in their accomplishments and in eager anticipation of future challenges, a sterling example and inspiration to all who would aspire to success.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED FIFTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, FIRST SESSION:
