The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 1042 addresses regulation and licensure for Nail Technologists under the Cosmetology, Electrology, Esthetics, Nail Technology and Body Art Practice Act. LB 1042:

-Removes minimum hours for licensure & instructors;

-Removes a requirement for bi-annual licensing exams;

-Addresses reciprocity requirements;

-Removes language regarding temporary practitioners;

-Clarifies license display requirements at salons;

-Addresses consumption of alcohol on salon premises;

-Changes physical description of requirements of a nail technology school & limitations for guest educators;

-Changes proof of age requirements for prospective students;

-Clarifies financial obligations for transfer students from one school to another; and

-Changes instructor to student ratio at schools of nail technology instruction.
