The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 345, introduced by Senator Craighead at the request of the Governor, is part of the Governor's occupational licensing reform package.

The bill strikes the requirement that abstracters have at least one year of experience prior to licensure or temporary certification. Nebraska is one of only six states to license abstracters, and the only state with this experience requirement.
