Legislative Bill 348, introduced at the request of the Governor, is part of the Governor's occupational licensing reform package.

The bill repeals the potato shipper license, eliminates an underutilized checkoff, and terminates the Nebraska Potato Development Fund.

LB 348 contains an effective date of August 1, 2017 and an emergency clause.
