The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 46 requires the Department of Motor Vehicles to design license plates to be known as "Choose Life" license plates. The design is to reflect support for the protection of Nebraska's children. Such plates would be available as alphanumeric or personalized message plates, with a maximum of 5 characters. In addition to other fees required for registration, each application for alphanumeric plates shall be accompanied by a fee of \$5, which is to be credited to the Nebraska Child Abuse Prevention Fund. For message plates, 75% of the \$40 fee shall be credited to such fund.
