The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 762 would extend the sunset date on the Department of Environmental Quality Scrap Tire Management Program, which assists in financing scrap tire projects in Nebraska. The sunset date was June 30, 2019, this bill would extend it to June 30, 2024. The funds for this program come from a one dollar per tire fee collected on the sale of new tires.
