Introducer's Statement of Intent

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

To allow for the allocation of fees from ignition interlock to be transferred directly to the Violence Prevention Cash Fund. This is not an additional fee but rather a division of the fees. This allocation takes \$25 from the \$45 fee taken for ignition interlock and credits that to the Violence Prevention Cash Fund as a minor yet sustainable revenue source for the Office of Violence Prevention which provides grant money to non-profits, advocacy groups, and law enforcement who provide programming, support, and alternative options for violence and gang activity.
