Introducer's Statement of Intent

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Currently, cities of the first class, second class and villages are prohibited from suspending the requirement that an ordinance be read by title on three different days for ordinances related to the annexation of territory. LB865 extends this provision to cities of the primary and metropolitan classes.

LB865 also provides that cities and villages cannot suspend the requirement for three separate readings for ordinances related to redrawing of district boundaries.
