Introducer's Statement of Intent

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 924 amends the Emergency Medicaid Services Practice Act to eliminate outdated language and provide flexibility in practice. The bill amends the Occupational Therapy Practice Act to allow internationally-educated individuals to obtain licensure in the State of Nebraska. LB 924 eliminates the requirement for signatures on license documents and modifies language contained in the Uniform Credentialing Act regarding the authority of the State to require criminal background checks to be in compliance with requirements of the Enhanced Nurse Licensure Compact.
