- 1 1. Strike original section 1 and insert the following new section:
- Section 1. (1) This section shall be known and may be cited as the 2
- 3 Neighbor Spoofing Protection Act.
- (2) No person shall, in connection with any telecommunications 4
- 5 service or IP-enabled voice service, cause any caller identification
- service to knowingly transmit misleading or inaccurate caller 6
- 7 identification information with the intent to defraud, cause harm, or
- 8 wrongfully obtain anything of value.
- (3) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent or 9
- restrict any person from blocking the capability of any caller 10
- identification service to transmit caller identification information. 11
- (4) This section shall not apply: 12
- 13 (a) To any authorized activity of a law enforcement agency; or
- (b) When a court order specifically authorizes the use of caller 14
- identification manipulation. 15
- (5) Except as provided in this section, local exchange carriers and 16
- telecommunications carriers shall not be responsible for enforcement of 17
- 18 this section.
- (6)(a) Notwithstanding section 75-156, the Public Service Commission 19
- 20 may, after hearing, impose an administrative penalty for a violation of
- 21 this section. The penalty for a violation shall not exceed two thousand
- 22 dollars. Every violation associated with a specific telephone number
- within the state shall be considered a separate and distinct violation. 23
- (b) The amount of an administrative penalty shall be based on: 24
- (i) The nature, circumstances, extent, and gravity of a prohibited 25
- 26 act;
- 27 (ii) The history of previous violations;

- 1 (iii) The amount necessary to deter future violations; and
- 2 <u>(iv) Any efforts to correct the violation.</u>
- 3 (c) The commission shall remit any administrative penalty collected
- 4 under this section to the State Treasurer for distribution in accordance
- 5 with Article VII, section 5, of the Constitution of Nebraska.
- 6 (d) Any administrative penalty may be appealed. The appeal shall be
 7 in accordance with section 75-136.
- 8 (7) Notwithstanding subsection (6) of this section, a violation of
- 9 this section shall be considered a violation of section 59-1602 and be
- 10 <u>subject to the Consumer Protection Act and any other law which provides</u>
- 11 for the implementation and enforcement of section 59-1602. A violation of
- 12 <u>this section does not give rise to a private cause of action.</u>
