1 1. Insert the following new section: Sec. 2. Each physician may inquire of a new patient who is at least 2 eighteen years of age and younger than forty-five years of age on the new 3 patient's intake form as to whether the patient is registered with the 4 5 bone marrow registry. If the patient states that the patient is not registered with the bone marrow registry, the physician may provide 6 7 information developed and disseminated by the Department of Health and Human Services regarding the bone marrow registry to the patient. 8 2. On page 2, line 14, after "(2)" insert "The department shall 9 provide information and educational materials to the public regarding 10 bone marrow donation. The department shall seek assistance from the 11 12 national marrow donor program to establish a system to distribute 13 materials, ensure that the materials are updated periodically, and fully disclose the risks involved in donating bone marrow.". 14 3. Renumber the remaining section accordingly. 15

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
