Note 1. We provided oral health care at the following FQHCs: Charles Drew, One World Commuity Health Center, CAPWN and Good Neighbor. The reduction in overall patient visits from Baseline Year to Year 2 is due to the greater complexity and severity of dental care needed by the FQHC patients. We spent more time provinding care to these patients as many had never been seen by a dentist before. It took more time to get them treated to an acceptable level of dental health.
