Note 1. We provided oral health care at the following FQHCs: Charles Drew, One World Commuity Health Center, CAPWN and Good Neighbor. The reduction in overall patient visits from Baseline Year to Year 2 is due to the greater complexity and severity of dental care needed by the FQHC patients.
