- * LB 34e (*Kolterman*) Change various retirement provisions
- LB 243e (*Gragert*) Create the Healthy Soils Task Force and add a use for a fund
- LB 449 (*Walz*) Prohibit scleral tattooing
- LB 619 (*Kolowski*) Prohibit denial of coverage for mental health services delivered in a school
- LB 217 (*Pansing Brooks*) Prohibit discrimination against an employee for communicating about employee wages, benefits, or other compensation
- * LB 269 (*Friesen*) Change provisions relating to ignition interlock permits and school permits
- LB 590 (*Briese*) Require use of Nebraska Early Childhood Professional Record System for documentation and verification of staff training
- * LB 270 (*Friesen*) Change provisions relating to motorboats, motor vehicles, state identification cards, and operators' licenses
