GENERAL FILE: 2019 CARRY-OVER PRIORITY BILLS

- LB 147 (*Groene*) Change the Student Discipline Act to provide for use by a teacher or administrator of necessary physical contact or physical restraint and provide procedures and grounds for removal from a class in response to student behavior
- LB 153 (*Brewer, at the request of the Governor*) Change provisions relating to the taxation of military retirement benefits

GENERAL FILE

- LB 287 (*Quick*) Change and provide duties for the Game and Parks Commission and change provisions relating to stamps, permits, fees, and hunter orange display requirements as prescribed
- LB 30 (*Kolterman*) Change and eliminate provisions under the Professional Landscape Architects Act
- LB 93 (*Wayne*) Provide for intervention by a biological parent in certain juvenile proceedings
- LB 206 (*Morfeld*) Protect free speech rights of student journalists and student media advisers
- LB 230 (*Pansing Brooks*) Provide for room confinement of juveniles as prescribed
