Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill relates to certificates of title for motorboats and motor vehicles. It amends two provisions by striking the language "husband and wife" and inserting "married couple". Those provisions currently allow one spouse to make an application for title on behalf of him or herself and as an agent for the other spouse. It does not change the requirements for application for title, but merely substitutes the term "married couple" for "husband and wife."
