Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 117 amends four sections of law relating to bidders for road and bridge construction contracts.

Section 1 amends Section 39-1351 by reducing the time for prequalification applications filed with the Nebraska Department of Transportation (NDOT) from 10 days before the bid letting to 5 days, unless fewer than 5 days is specified by the NDOT. It also amends the criteria for prequalification approval by inserting language relating to bonding capacity or other sufficient financial showing deemed sufficient by NDOT, and striking language relating toequipment and financial resources.

Section 2 amends Section 39-1352 by removing a requirement that a CPA or permitted

public accountant certify financial information provided by prospective bidders. Section 3 amends Section 39-1353 to harmonize language relating to bids from pre-qualified bidders.

Section 4 amends Section 39-1354 to allow NDOT, in its discretion, to provide paper or electronic reproductions of plans to prospective bidders. Current law allows NDOT to receive reimbursement not to exceed to the expense of reproducing the plans.
