LB 135 amends Neb. Rev. Stat. 38-1220 which lists the persons and organizations that are exempt from the Emergency Medical Services Practice Act.

LB 135 amends subsection (7) to insert language that would also exempt students under the supervision of an organization accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs for the level of training the student is completing. (Page 2, lines 27-31.)
