## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 177 would extend the termination date for limited bonding authority provided to natural resources districts containing a metropolitan class city from 2019 to 2029.

## **Explanation of amendments:**

AM 713 would extend the termination date for five years, rather than ten. As amended the bill does the following:

Section 1 amends 2-3226.14, which authorizes natural resources district use of flood protection and water quality enhancement bonds, by extending the termination date of the authority from December 31, 2019 to December 31, 2024.

Section 2 repeals the original section.
