This bill would amend section 44-1984 of the Title Insurers Act which provides that a title insurer shall issue closing or settlement protection covering a proposed insured if the title insurer "issues a title insurance commitment or title insurance policy". The bill would change this to provide that a title insurer shall issue closing or settlement protection covering a proposed insured if the title insurer "or its title insurance agent engages in any escrow, settlement, closing services relating to the issuance of a title insurance commitment or title insurance policy to a proposed insured".
