## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

**Brief Summary** 

LB 256 allows members of the community college boards of governors to participate in insurance coverage offered to community college employees.

Section-by-Section Summary

Section 1

A board member may participate in the insurance coverage offered to community college employees, if:

- 1. The board permits participation; and
- 2. The electing board member pays the employee and the employer portion of the insurance coverage.

This includes any hospitalization, medical, surgical, accident, sickness, or term life insurance coverage.

If the board permits its members to participate in insurance coverage, the board is required to report quarterly at a board meeting a list of those board members who elected to participate in the insurance coverage.

This list must be made available in the board's office for public review if requested.
