## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 347 amends the Massage Therapy Practice Act, specifically the provisions in section 38-1708, which exempts certain groups from licensure under the Act.

LB 347 inserts a new subsection (5) into 38-1708 to exempt from licensure individuals engaged in the practice of reflexology whose practice is limited to the application of specific pressure by the practitioner's hands, thumbs, or fingers to the soft tissue of the hands, feet, and outer ears and whose services are not designated as or implied to be massage or massage therapy. (Page 2, lines 20-24.)
