Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 385 amends Section 82-101.01 to change details of the election process for members of the Board of Trustees for the Nebraska State Historical Society. Ballots must be mailed to the active members of the society who are eligible to vote. This bill would authorize the secretary of the society to deliver these ballots electronically. It would also require that ballots and other election records to be preserved for one year following an election.

The provisions of LB 385 were included in the committee amendment (AM 548) to LB 447.
