Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Current law requires a county assessor to certify by August 20 of each year the current taxable value of real and personal property subject to a levy. This information is provided to the relevant governing body or board.

This bill would provide that if a political subdivision annexes property since the last required certification, that political subdivision would have to send notice of the annexation to the county clerk. If that notice arrives prior to July 1, it would make that taxable value part of the taxable valuation for that political subdivision. If the notice arrives on or after July 1, that taxable value would be part of the following year's taxable valuation.
