Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB56 would amend current law governing special designated licenses to give local governing bodies the ability to create an expedited process for obtaining a special designated license for those who have a catering license and allows local governing bodies to set the deadline for an expedited application between 12 to 21 days prior to the event. The bill also allows a special designated license issued by the commission to be delivered electronically.

The changes made by LB56 per section are as follows:

Section One: Amends 53-124.11 to add language allowing for electronic delivery of any special designated license.

Section Two: Amends 53-124.13 to add language giving a local governing body authority to create an expedited application process for special designated licenses for those who have a catering license and allowing the local governing body to set the deadline for an expedited application between 12 to 21 days prior to the event.

Section Three: Repeals original sections.
