Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 580 would amend section 13-2042 and 13.2042.01 to increase the per ton dumping fee paid to the Department of Environment and Energy by landfill operators under the Nebraska Integrated Solid Waste Management Act from \$1.25 to \$2.00. The \$0.75 differential would be rebated back to the originating landfill entity and used specifically for residential household hazardous waste facilities and/or household hazardous waste collection events. This rebate would replace the current Waste Reduction and Recycling Grant funds that have been used to fund the state's household hazardous waste facilities and collection events.
