Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 606 would create a new section of statute to allow natural resources districts to sell real property associated with streamflow operation projects while retaining the ability to pump ground water for augmentation purposes. The natural resources district operating the project would be allowed to allocate the amount of ground water that may be removed for streamflow enhancement without taking into account the amount of land area or acres owned by the project.
