Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LR 13 would urge federal agencies with responsibility for food labeling to establish and enforce product nomenclature rules that clearly distinguish plant-based milk analogue products from milk and milk products conforming to referenced standards of identity for such products.

Explanation of amendments:

The committee amendment (AM435) rewrites the whereas clauses of the resolution to utilize consistent terminology throughout and to resolve a typo in the third whereas clause. Resolved clause 1.c. is revised to address awkward sentence structure and for clarification of the purpose of the clause.
