Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

Any fiscal impact(s) associated with the original provisions of LB1003 as technically amended by AM2651 would be contingent upon action of a relevant city of the second class or village under specific annexation authority as would be authorized under the related provisions of the bill.

AM2651 to LB1003 incorporated provisions of eight other municipality-related bills into LB1003 as explained and identified in the committee statement related to LB1003. Fiscal note comments associated with these bills incorporated into LB1003 include:

Provisions of LB795 amended into LB1003 would amend the Enterprise Zone Act to allow the American Community Survey 5-Year Estimate to be used to determine unemployment rates in proposed enterprise zones. It is estimated that there would be no fiscal impact to the Department of Economic Development.

Provisions of LB799 amended into LB1003 include amendments to various statutes relating to municipalities that are technical, clarifying and harmonizing in nature and appear to represent no fiscal impact.

Provisions of LB801 amended into LB1003 would have no fiscal impact on state agencies. It is anticipated that any impact to political subdivisions would be minimal in nature.

Provisions of LB821 amended into LB1003 amend provisions relating to the scheduling and cancellation of planning commission meetings as such relates to cities of the first and second class and villages. The provisions as amended represent no definitive fiscal impact to the relevant municipalities.

Provisions of LB885 amended into LB1003 would amend a section of law governing the Civic and Community Center Financing Act. Under LB 885, grant applications for projects relating to historic buildings or districts would be required to include a notification of approval from the State Historic Preservation Officer. It is estimated that there would be no fiscal impact to the Department of Economic Development, the agency that administers the grant program. There may be additional costs incurred by the State Historical Society to carry out grant application project reviews. Any costs would depend upon future requests developed and submitted by political subdivisions, and cannot be estimated at this time.

Provisions of LB957 amended into LB1003 change provisions related to quorum requirements for cities of the first and second class. No fiscal impact.

Provisions of LB984 amended into LB1003 change provisions related to the timing of filling vacancies on certain boards, authorities, and agencies. No fiscal impact.

Provisions of LB993 amended into LB1003 change provisions related to the number of residents and number of city council members for cities which adopt the city manager plan of government. No fiscal impact.
