**Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.**

This bill, as amended by AM2551, would change requirements for witnessing death penalty executions.

It provides that persons required to be present for an execution shall continuously witness the execution process from the moment the convicted person enters the execution chamber until the convicted person is declared dead or the execution is halted.

It appears that this bill will not have any significant fiscal impact to the state or political subdivisions.
