Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 378 exempts persons 21 years of age or older who are operating or a passenger on an autocycle, a motorcycle, or moped from wearing a protective helmet. A requirement for autocycle, motorcycle, and moped operators to wear eye protection is placed in statute.

A one-time potential fiscal impact is present as the Department of Transportation (DOT) would need to update signage at border crossings to reflect a change in the helmet law, this amount is indeterminate.

The DOT has provided a fiscal note (see attached) that indicates no fiscal impact is anticipated by the department. In 2018, the DOT provided a fiscal note for a nearly identical bill (LB 368) and it was indicated there would be a one-time \$23,000 cost for modifying signs at state border crossings to reflect the change in the helmet law, but that it could have been absorbed by the department without a change in their appropriation.
