**Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.**

LB 462, as amended, changes provisions of the One-Call Notification System Act and the Nebraska Telecommunications Regulation Act.

Sections 3 through 6 provide definitions for “Person”, “Center”, “Locator”, and “Ticket” for purposes of the Act.

Section 7 requires the center, which shall be governed by a board of directors, to carry out the One-Call Notification System Act. The board of directors shall have the authority to propose rules and regulations which may be adopted and promulgated pursuant to this section and have such other authority as provided by rules and regulations adopted and promulgated by the Fire Marshal.

Section 8 requires locators acting as a contractor for an operator to perform location services to be trained in locator standards and practices applicable to the industry.

Section 9 requires any plastic or nonmetallic underground facilities installed underground on or after January 1, 2021 to be installed in such a manner as to be locatable, either by mapping or by use of tracer wire, by the operator for purposes of the act.

Section 10 requires the board of directors to assess the effectiveness of enforcement programs, enforcement actions, and its damage prevention and public awareness programs and report such to the Governor and Legislature no later than December 1, 2021 and every odd-numbered year thereafter.

Sections 19 and 20 provide definitions for “Voice over Internet protocol service” and “Internet-protocol-enabled services” for the Nebraska Telecommunications Regulation Act.

Section 21 prohibits the Public Service Commission from regulating Interexchange services, voice over Internet protocol service and Internet-protocol-enabled service.

Neither the State Fire Marshal nor the Public Service Commission estimate any fiscal impact.
