Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

This bill requires the Department of Health and Human Services to use the Nebraska Early Childhood Professional Record System (NECPRS) to document training levels of staff and verify that minimum training requirements have been met. Each employee of a child care program would also report their educational degrees, professional credentials held, relevant training completed and work history to NECPRS. The NECPRS is operated by the Department of Education.

Department of Health and Human Services staff would train child care providers. Minor costs are anticipated for training child care employees on the use of the NECPRS and programming modifications. These costs can be handled within existing resources.

The Department of Education currently has over 9,000 accounts and the capacity to handle the additional records. There is no fiscal impact to the Department of Education.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB 590 requires all licensed child care providers and staff to register with the Nebraska Early Childhood Professional Record System (NECPRS). NECPRS is maintained through the Nebraska Department of Education. LB 0590 would be effective January 1, 2020.

The Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) will be required to complete a minor rule and regulation change as a result of LB 0590. DHHS would absorb the costs listed below to complete this regulation change.

DHHS would incur additional costs to coordinate with the Nebraska Department of Education to develop and provide written instructions and training to child care providers to use NECPRS. Licensed Child Care Directors would receive training at scheduled child care conferences and workshops. Instructions will also be available on the Department's website. Training for new licensees will be conducted and included in child care orientation materials.

It is anticipated that some child care programs would contact their licensing inspector if they experienced issues with setting up or entering information onto their training record. There are 23 field inspectors across the state. It's estimated that each inspector could spend approximately 1 hour each in providing technical assistance to providers who contact them for help.

This new work would be absorbed by existing staff. The estimated labor burden associated with implementing LB 590 is as follows:
