1 Section 1. Section 18-1720, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 3 18-1720 (1) All cities and villages in this state are hereby
- 4 granted power and authority by ordinance to define, regulate, suppress
- 5 and prevent nuisances, and to declare what shall constitute a nuisance,
- 6 and to abate and remove the same. Every city and village is authorized to
- 7 exercise such power and authority within its zoning jurisdiction.
- 8 (2) Any city or village may enter into an interlocal agreement
- 9 pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act with a county in which the
- 10 extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction of the city or village is located to
- 11 provide for joint and cooperative action to abate, remove, or prevent
- 12 <u>nuisances within such extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction. The governing</u>
- 13 body of such city or village and the county board of such county shall
- 14 first approve such interlocal agreement by ordinance or resolution.

- 16 Nebraska, is repealed.
