- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds for
- 2 the payment of the salaries and benefits of certain state officers
- 3 for FY2019-20 and FY2020-21; to define terms; to provide an
- 4 operative date; and to declare an emergency.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. APPROPRIATION LANGUAGE.
- There are hereby appropriated, for FY2019-20 and FY2020-21, the
- 3 amounts specified in this act, or so much as may be necessary, for the
- 4 salaries and benefits of officers of the Nebraska state government.
- 5 Sec. 2. DEFINITION OF APPROPRIATION PERIOD.
- 6 For purposes of this act, FY2019-20 means the period beginning July
- 7 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2020, and FY2020-21 means the period
- 8 beginning July 1, 2020, and ending June 30, 2021.
- 9 Sec. 3. NEBRASKA ACCOUNTING SYSTEM MANUAL DEFINITIONS.
- 10 The definitions contained in the Nebraska Accounting System Manual,
- 11 and any amendments thereto, on file with the Clerk of the Legislature are
- 12 hereby adopted by the Legislature as the definitions for this act, except
- 13 as provided in section 21 of this act.
- 14 Sec. 4. DRAWING AND PAYING WARRANTS.
- 15 The Director of Administrative Services shall draw warrants upon the
- 16 proper fund in the state treasury for an amount not to exceed the
- 17 appropriations set forth in this act upon presentation of proper
- 18 documentation. The State Treasurer shall pay the warrants out of the
- 19 appropriate funds.
- 20 Workers' compensation premium assessments shall not be paid from the
- 21 programs listed in this act.

- 17 Sec. 21. LIMITATION ON SALARIES, WAGES, AND PER DIEMS.
- 18 (1) As used in this act:
- 19 (a) SALARY LIMIT means total expenditures for permanent and 20 temporary salaries and per diems; and
- 21 (b) Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per 22 diems means all remuneration paid to employees treated as taxable compensation by the Internal Revenue Service or subject to social 23 24 security coverage, specifically including payments accounted for as vacation, holidays, sick leave, military leave, funeral leave, maternity 25 leave, administrative leave, compensatory time, deferred compensation, or 26 any other similar form, and amounts withheld pursuant to law, 27 28 excluding state contributions for social security, retirement, 29 employee insurance plans.
- 30 (2) Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per 31 diems are limited to the amount provided by law for constitutional

- 1 officers.
- 2 (3) The limitation on expenditures for permanent and temporary
- 3 salaries and per diems for FY2019-20 shall be increased by certified
- 4 encumbrance amounts from FY2018-19 for permanent and temporary salaries
- 5 and per diems. The limitation on expenditures for permanent and temporary
- 6 salaries and per diems for FY2020-21 shall be increased by certified
- 7 encumbrance amounts from FY2019-20 for permanent and temporary salaries
- 8 and per diems. Encumbered amounts shall be calculated in accordance with
- 9 section 81-138.01.
- 10 Sec. 22. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2019.
- 11 Sec. 23. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 12 passed and approved according to law.
