FINAL READING

Introduced by Howard, 9.

Read first time April 17, 2019

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to aid
- 2 in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 460, One Hundred
- 3 Sixth Legislature, First Session, 2019; and to declare an emergency.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated \$12,480 from federal funds
2 for FY2020-21 to the Department of Health and Human Services, for Program
3 33, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 460, One
4 Hundred Sixth Legislature, First Session, 2019.

5 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
6 for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this
7 section.

8 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$1,469,893 from federal
9 funds for FY2019-20 and (2) \$1,959,858 from federal funds for FY2020-21
10 to the Department of Health and Human Services, for Program 347, to aid
11 in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 460, One Hundred Sixth
12 Legislature, First Session, 2019.

13 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
14 for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this
15 section.

16 Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$509,553 from the General
17 Fund and \$637,016 from the Nebraska State Patrol Cash Fund for FY2019-20
18 and (2) \$205,853 from the General Fund and \$624,295 from the Nebraska
19 State Patrol Cash Fund for FY2020-21 to the Nebraska State Patrol, for
20 Program 100, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill
21 460, One Hundred Sixth Legislature, First Session, 2019.

22 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per
23 diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$486,026
24 for FY2019-20 or \$486,026 for FY2020-21.

25 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
26 passed and approved according to law.
