- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the State Electrical Act; to amend sections
- 2 81-2101, 81-2106, and 81-2108, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska;
- 3 to authorize a licensing exception; to harmonize provisions; and to
- 4 repeal the original sections.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 81-2101, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
2 amended to read:

3 81-2101 Sections 81-2101 to 81-2143 and section 4 of this act shall
4 be known and may be cited as the State Electrical Act.

5 Sec. 2. Section 81-2106, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
6 amended to read:

7 81-2106 Except as provided in section 81-2108, 81-2110, or 81-2112
8 or section 4 of this act, no person shall, for another, plan, lay out, or
9 supervise the installation of wiring, apparatus, or equipment for
10 electrical light, heat, power, or ~~and~~ other purposes unless he or she is
11 licensed by the board as a Class B electrical contractor, an electrical
12 contractor, a Class A master electrician, or a Class B master
13 electrician.

14 Sec. 3. Section 81-2108, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
15 amended to read:

16 81-2108 (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section or
17 in section 81-2110 or 81-2112 or section 4 of this act, no person shall,
18 for another, wire for or install electrical wiring, apparatus, or
19 equipment unless he or she is licensed by the board as a Class B
20 electrical contractor, an electrical contractor, a Class A master
21 electrician, a Class B master electrician, or a fire alarm installer.

22 (2) Except as provided in section 81-2106, 81-2110, or 81-2112 or
23 section 4 of this act, no person shall wire for or install electrical
24 wiring, apparatus, or equipment or supervise an apprentice electrician
25 unless such person is licensed as a Class B journeyman electrician, a
26 journeyman electrician, a residential journeyman electrician, or a fire
27 alarm installer and is employed by a Class B electrical contractor, an
28 electrical contractor, a Class A master electrician, a Class B master
29 electrician, or a fire alarm installer.

30 For purposes of this section, the holder of a fire alarm installer
31 license shall only supervise those apprentices engaged in the

1 installation of fire alarm equipment and apparatus operating at fifty
2 volts or less.

3 (3) No person licensed under the State Electrical Act may lend his
4 or her license to any person or knowingly permit the use of such license
5 by another.

6 Sec. 4. A person who is a directional boring contractor may install
7 underground conduit under the direct supervision of a Class A master
8 electrician, Class B master electrician, journeyman electrician, or Class
9 B journeyman electrician who is employed by an electrical contractor.

10 Sec. 5. Original sections 81-2101, 81-2106, and 81-2108, Reissue
11 Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
