1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to civil procedure; to amend section
2 25-21,186, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide for
3 immunity from civil liability for entering a motor vehicle to remove
4 a child in an emergency as prescribed; and to repeal the original
5 section.

6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 25-21,186, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,
2 is amended to read:

3 25-21,186 (1) No person who renders emergency care at the scene of
4 an accident or other emergency gratuitously, shall be held liable for any
5 civil damages as a result of any act or omission by such person in
6 rendering the emergency care or as a result of any act or failure to act
7 to provide or arrange for medical treatment or care for the injured
8 person.

9 (2) For purposes of this section, rendering emergency care at the
10 scene of an accident or other emergency includes entering a motor vehicle
11 to remove a child when entering the vehicle and removing the child is
12 necessary to avoid immediate harm to the child.
