- 3 25-21,186 (1) No person who renders emergency care at the scene of
- 4 an accident or other emergency gratuitously, shall be held liable for any
- 5 civil damages as a result of any act or omission by such person in
- 6 rendering the emergency care or as a result of any act or failure to act
- 7 to provide or arrange for medical treatment or care for the injured
- 8 person.
- 9 (2) For purposes of this section, rendering emergency care at the
- 10 scene of an accident or other emergency includes entering a motor vehicle
- 11 to remove a child when entering the vehicle and removing the child is
- 12 <u>necessary to avoid immediate harm to the child.</u>
