Section 1. Section 18-1720, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
amended to read:

3 18-1720 (1) All cities and villages in this state are hereby 4 granted power and authority by ordinance to define, regulate, suppress 5 and prevent nuisances, and to declare what shall constitute a nuisance, 6 and to abate and remove the same. Every city and village is authorized to 7 exercise such power and authority within its zoning jurisdiction.

8 (2) Any city or village may enter into an interlocal agreement 9 pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act with a county in which the 10 extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction of the city or village is located to 11 provide for joint and cooperative action to abate, remove, or prevent 12 nuisances within such extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction. The governing 13 body of such city or village and the county board of such county shall 14 first approve such interlocal agreement by ordinance or resolution.
