- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Property Assessed Clean Energy Act; to
- 2 amend section 13-3210, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2018;
- 3 to change provisions relating to jointly created and administered
- 4 clean energy assessment districts; and to repeal the original
- 5 section.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 13-3210, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
2 2018, is amended to read:

3 13-3210 (1) Two or more municipalities may enter into an agreement
4 pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act to jointly create, administer,
5 or create and administer for the creation, administration, or creation
6 and administration of clean energy assessment districts. Such districts
7 may be separate, overlapping, or coterminous and may be created anywhere
8 within the municipalities that entered into the agreement or within their
9 extraterritorial zoning jurisdictions, except that such districts shall
10 not include any area within the corporate boundaries or extraterritorial
11 zoning jurisdiction of any city or village unless such city or village is
12 one of the municipalities that entered into the agreement. The agreement
13 shall provide for a governing body for any such district, which shall be
14 made up of members of the governing bodies of the municipalities that
15 entered into the agreement.

16 (2) If the creation of clean energy assessment districts is
17 implemented jointly by two or more municipalities, a single public
18 hearing held jointly by the cooperating municipalities is sufficient to
19 satisfy the requirements of section 13-3204.

20 (3) A municipality or municipalities may contract with a third party
21 for the administration of clean energy assessment districts.
