- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska National Guard; to amend
- 2 section 23-3211, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2018; to
- 3 state the rights of members of the Nebraska National Guard; to
- 4 provide for confidentiality of Nebraska National Guard members'
- 5 residential addresses; and to repeal the original section.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. The rights of a member of the Nebraska National Guard in
2 the State of Nebraska shall include, but not be limited to, the right to:
3 (1) Seek employment with state, county, and local government;
4 (2) Not have membership in the Nebraska National Guard impact such
5 member's right to donate to political parties when not on duty status;
6 (3) Participate with state, county, or local government in a law
7 enforcement function as prescribed by that government;
8 (4) Receive the same protections a law enforcement officer is
9 afforded under section 23-3211 if the member is acting as a law
10 enforcement officer pursuant to subdivision (3) of this section; and
11 (5) Protection of such member's personal information as afforded
12 personnel of public bodies pursuant to subdivision (7) of section
13 84-712.05.

14 Sec. 2. Section 23-3211, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
15 2018, is amended to read:

16 23-3211 Unless requested in writing, the county assessor and
17 register of deeds shall withhold from the public the residential address
18 of a law enforcement officer or member of the Nebraska National Guard
19 acting pursuant to subdivision (3) of section 1 of this act who applies
20 to the county assessor in the county of his or her residence. The
21 application shall be in a form prescribed by the county assessor and
22 shall include the applicant's name, and address, and certified law
23 enforcement identification number of the law enforcement officer and the
24 parcel identification number for his or her residential address. A law
25 enforcement officer shall include in the application his or her law
26 enforcement identification number. A member of the Nebraska National
27 Guard shall include in the application proof of his or her status as a
28 member, in a manner prescribed by the county assessor. The county
29 assessor shall notify the register of deeds regarding the receipt of a
30 complete application. The county assessor and the register of deeds shall
31 withhold the address of a law enforcement officer or member of the

1 Nebraska National Guard who complies with this section for five years
2 after receipt of a complete application. The ~~law enforcement~~ officer or
3 member may renew his or her application every five years upon submission
4 of an updated application.
