- 2 71-2097, 71-2098, and 71-20,100, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 3 Nebraska; to redefine a term; to change provisions relating to
- 4 distribution of the Nursing Facility Penalty Cash Fund; to harmonize
- 5 provisions; and to repeal the original sections.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. Section 71-2097, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 3 71-2097 For purposes of sections 71-2097 to 71-20,101:
- 4 (1) Civil penalty includes penalties include any remedy remedies
- 5 required under federal law and includes include the imposition of a civil
- 6 <u>money penalty</u> monetary penalties;
- 7 (2) Department means the Department of Health and Human Services;
- 8 (3) Federal regulations for participation in the medicaid program
- 9 means the regulations found in 42 C.F.R. parts 442 and 483, as amended,
- 10 for participation in the medicaid program under Title XIX of the federal
- 11 Social Security Act, as amended; and
- 12 (4) Nursing facility means any intermediate care facility or nursing
- 13 facility, as defined in sections 71-420 and 71-424, which receives
- 14 federal and state funds under Title XIX of the federal Social Security
- 15 Act, as amended.
- Sec. 2. Section 71-2098, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 18 71-2098 (1) The department may assess, enforce, and collect civil
- 19 penalties against a nursing facility which the department has found in
- 20 violation of federal regulations for participation in the medicaid
- 21 program pursuant to the authority granted to the department under section
- 22 81-604.03.
- 23 (2) If the department finds that a violation is life threatening to
- 24 one or more residents or creates a direct threat of serious adverse harm
- 25 to one or more residents, a civil penalty shall be imposed for each day
- 26 the deficiencies which constitute the violation exist. The department may
- 27 assess an appropriate civil penalty for other violations based on the
- 28 nature of the violation. Any <u>civil money monetary</u> penalty assessed shall
- 29 not be less than fifty dollars nor more than ten thousand dollars for
- 30 each day the facility is found to be in violation of such federal
- 31 regulations. Any civil money penalty Monetary penalties assessed shall

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1 include interest at the rate specified in section 45-104.02, as such rate

- 2 may from time to time be adjusted.

- 5 71-20,100 (1) The Nursing Facility Penalty Cash Fund is created. Any
- 6 <u>civil money penalty</u> Monetary penalties collected by the department <u>as</u>
- 7 part of any civil penalty imposed pursuant to section 71-2098 or in
- 8 accordance with the federal Social Security Act, as amended, and imposed
- 9 by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services pursuant to 42 C.F.R.
- 10 488.431 and disbursed to the department in accordance with 42 C.F.R.
- 11 <u>488.433 or imposed by the department pursuant to 42 C.F.R. 488.432</u> shall
- 12 be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to such fund. The state
- 13 investment officer shall invest any money in the fund available for
- 14 investment pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the
- 15 Nebraska State Funds Investment Act.
- 16 (2) The department shall adopt and promulgate rules and regulations
- 17 which establish circumstances under which the department may distribute
- 18 funds from the Nursing Facility Penalty Cash Fund <u>in accordance with the</u>
- 19 <u>federal Social Security Act, as amended, and the to protect the health or</u>
- 20 property of individuals residing in nursing facilities which the
- 21 department has found in violation of federal regulations for
- 22 participation in the medicaid program, to support activities that benefit
- 23 nursing home residents as provided in 42 C.F.R. 488.433.—Circumstances
- 24 considered as a basis for distribution from the fund include paying costs
- 25 to:
- 26 (a) Relocate residents to other facilities;
- 27 (b) Maintain the operation of a nursing facility pending correction
- 28 of violations;
- 29 (c) Close a nursing facility; and
- 30 (d) Reimburse residents for personal funds lost.
