- 1 Section 1. Section 44-1984, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 44-1984 (1) No insurer that transacts any line of business other
- 4 than title insurance shall be eligible for the issuance or renewal of a
- 5 certificate of authority to transact the business of title insurance in
- 6 this state nor shall title insurance be transacted, underwritten, or
- 7 issued by any insurer transacting or authorized to transact any other
- 8 line of business.
- 9 (2)(a) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, and to the
- 10 extent such coverage is lawful within this state, a title insurer shall
- 11 issue closing or settlement protection covering a proposed insured if the
- 12 title insurer or its title insurance agent engages in any escrow,
- 13 <u>settlement</u>, or closing services relating to the issuance of a title
- 14 insurance commitment or title insurance policy to a proposed insured
- 15 issues a title insurance commitment or title insurance policy. Such
- 16 closing or settlement protection shall conform to the terms of coverage
- 17 and form of instrument as required by the director and shall indemnify a
- 18 proposed insured solely against loss of settlement funds only because of
- 19 the following acts of a title insurer's named title insurance agent:
- 20 (i) Theft of settlement funds; and
- 21 (ii) Failure to comply with written closing instructions by the
- 22 proposed insured when agreed to by the title insurance agent relating to
- 23 title insurance coverage.
- 24 (b) The director may prescribe or approve a required charge for
- 25 providing the coverage.
- 26 (c) A title insurer shall not provide any other coverage which
- 27 purports to indemnify against improper acts or omissions of a person with
- 28 regard to escrow, settlement, or closing services.
