1 Section 1. Section 27-801, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 3 27-801 The following definitions apply under this article:
- 4 (1) A statement is (a) an oral or written assertion or (b) nonverbal
- 5 conduct of a person, if it is intended by him or her as an assertion;
- 6 (2) A declarant is a person who makes a statement;
- 7 (3) Hearsay is a statement, other than one made by the declarant
- 8 while testifying at the trial or hearing, offered in evidence to prove
- 9 the truth of the matter asserted; and
- 10 (4) A statement is not hearsay if:
- 11 (a) The declarant testifies at the trial or hearing and is subject
- 12 to cross-examination concerning the statement, and the statement  $\pm s$  (i)
- 13 <u>is</u> inconsistent with his <u>or her</u> testimony and was given under oath
- 14 subject to the penalty of perjury at a trial, hearing, or other
- 15 proceeding, or in a deposition, or (ii) is consistent with his or her
- 16 testimony and is offered to rebut an express or implied charge against
- 17 him <u>or her</u>of recent fabrication or improper influence or motive, or
- 18 (iii) identifies a person as someone the declarant perceived earlier; or
- 19 (b) The statement is offered against a party and is (i) his <u>or her</u>
- 20 own statement, in either his or her individual or a representative
- 21 capacity,  $\Theta$  (ii) a statement of which he <u>or she</u> has manifested his <u>or</u>
- 22 <u>her</u> adoption or belief in its truth, <del>or</del> (iii) a statement by a person
- 23 authorized by him or her to make a statement concerning the subject, or
- 24 (iv) a statement by his or her agent or servant within the scope of his
- 25 or her agency or employment, or (v) a statement by a coconspirator of a
- 26 party during the course and in furtherance of the conspiracy.
