- 2 and 42-110, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change
- 3 terminology; and to repeal the original sections.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 42-103, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 3 42-103 Marriages are void (1) when either party has a spouse husband
- 4 or wife living at the time of the marriage, (2) when either party, at the
- 5 time of marriage, is mentally incompetent to enter into the marriage
- 6 relation, and (3) when the parties are related to each other as parent
- 7 and child, grandparent and grandchild, brother and sister of half as well
- 8 as whole blood, first cousins when of whole blood, uncle and niece, and
- 9 aunt and nephew. This subdivision extends to children and relatives born
- 10 out of wedlock as well as those born in wedlock.
- 11 Sec. 2. Section 42-109, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 12 amended to read:
- 13 42-109 In the solemnization of marriage, no particular form shall be
- 14 required, except that the parties shall solemnly declare, in the presence
- 15 of the magistrate or minister and the attending witnesses, that they take
- 16 each other in marriage. There as husband and wife; and in any case there
- 17 shall be at least two witnesses, besides the minister or magistrate
- 18 present at the ceremony.
- 19 Sec. 3. Section 42-110, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 20 amended to read:
- 21 42-110 Whenever a marriage <u>has</u> shall have been solemnized pursuant
- 22 to the provisions of sections 42-101 to 42-117, the minister of
- 23 magistrate who solemnized the marriage same shall give to each of the
- 24 parties, on request, a certificate signed by the minister or magistrate
- 25 under his hand, specifying the names, ages, and places of residence of
- 26 the parties married, the names and residences of at least two witnesses
- 27 who were present at such marriage, and the time and place thereof.
- 28 Sec. 4. Original sections 42-103, 42-109, and 42-110, Reissue
- 29 Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
