- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to offenses against animals; to prohibit
- 2 restraining animals in the event of certain natural or manmade
- disasters or severe weather events as prescribed; and to provide a
- 4 penalty.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1) No animal shall be restrained with a chain, rope,
- 2 cord, tether, cable, or similar device and left unsheltered or unattended
- 3 in the event of a severe weather event or natural or manmade disaster
- 4 including, but not limited to, during a tornado warning issued for the
- 5 <u>jurisdiction</u> by the National Weather Service or after a mandatory or
- 6 voluntary evacuation order has been issued for the jurisdiction by a
- 7 governmental authority.
- 8 (2) For purposes of this section:
- 9 (a) Animal means an animal kept as a household pet for the purpose
- 10 of companionship, including, but not limited to, a dog, cat, bird,
- 11 rabbit, rodent, and reptile; and
- 12 <u>(b) Severe weather event means the existence of severe climatic</u>
- 13 conditions creating rain, hail, sleet, snow, high winds, extremely high
- 14 or low temperatures, or any combination thereof that would endanger the
- 15 <u>safety of an animal restrained as described in subsection (1) of this</u>
- 16 section.
- 17 (3) Any person who violates this section is quilty of a Class I
- 18 misdemeanor.
